Hurricane Lilies, Lycoris Species, in Florida 3 Less Common Hurricane Lilies Lycoris albiflora (white spider lily) produces clusters of 6 to 8 white flowers on a stem 12 to 18 inches tall Each petal may have a narrow creamy-pink stripe down the center, but the stripe (and flower) fades to white with age Like red
